Canadian Small Bore National Championships

National championships for small-bore rifle were held in Beachburg, Ontario this year. We were shooting three events at this competition, which were Free rifle three position, Free rifle Prone, and the Air rifle event. Each athlete shot all events. Our coach and fellow teammate Cory Niefer won 1st place in all three events, and won the grand aggregate award, which is a total cumulative score across of all three events.

The two new shooters from Saskatchewan, Cassandra Wilson-Anderson and Kristen Andersen, showed a promising future for the sport in the province. There were record-breaking performances from the Junior men side of our team, with Matt McDermott, Justin Nenson and Elliott Field breaking the old records in the team events for Three position and Prone. All in all, this competition was a great learning experience for our team, and we are looking forward to see what we can do next year as a team.

2007 Canadian Grand Prix

The Canadian air-gun grand prix was held at the Double Tree hotel, in Toronto Ontario. This competition was special for our team for a variety of reasons. First of all, we brought down nine people, which was the largest team that we have ever taken down to this competition. Second, this competition was important for the Canada games athletes, because it gave them an opportunity to compete with many of the same athletes, which will be at the Canada Games in Whitehorse. Our coach and fellow teammate Cory Niefer won 1st overall, and Drew Schreuder placed 3rd overall. The junior team did well, with our newest teammate Cassandra Wilson-Anderson placing 9th overall female, with one point away from making the final.
