29. Notice may be given at this meeting of any proposed changes in the bylaws or articles of the Corporation which shall be considered at the Annual Meeting, or any adjournments thereof, but no changes in the bylaws or articles shall be made except at the Annual Meeting or any adjournment thereof, and no such resolution shall be proposed unless a notice in writing of the terms of such resolution signed by two members as proposer and seconder thereof, shall have been given to the Secretary-Treasurer at least two months previous to the Annual Meeting at which time the same is to be proposed, and it shall be the duty of the Secretary-Treasurer to notify all members of the Corporation of such proposed amendments one month prior to the Annual Meeting.

Hello all you Black Powder people,

I guess this could be called a 'News Bulletin'.

The Governing body we used to get our accreditation from was the SFC as you may have noticed on your Score Books. A couple years ago there was a change and we now are affiliated with the SRAC, Silhouette Rifle Association of Canada. Any recent Score Books have had this on them. Leo and I did some probing into why the Black Powder Cartridge Rifle Silhouette pages had been dropped from the book. It turns out this was only true for the years 2007 and 2008 due to an error. We have received an apology from the President of the SRAC. I have also received a supply of Score Books for 2010 and they do have our pages in them. The price remains the same at \$5.00.

And now the 'really big' news. While speaking with Neil Suttill, the President of the SRAC, we asked why there was not a National Match for our sport. He explained that it was pretty much due to the fact that no one had asked before. To accomplish this some one has to represent us with the SRAC as the Vice-President in charge of BPCRS. This would need to be done at the Annual Meeting of the SRAC which this year is in Kamloops, BC the weekend of July 18th. Of course 'rules would have to be followed' but we don't see a problem. It is our intention to send a delegation to the meeting with the intention of establishing our Sport at the National level in Canada. If all goes well we propose that in July of 2011 in place of the Pingert we would hold the first ever,

"Canadian National Black Powder Cartridge Rifle Silhouette Championships"

At this time we do not know what costs might be involved or if we could hold the match at Bethune. The other matches are held in Kamloops. But we think it is worth asking the questions and are pretty excited about the prospects.
