

2011 Canada Winter Games Selection Criteria – Air Rifle

The SPSBA will select 2 females and 2 males (plus one female and 1 male as for the "alternate" position, in case the one of the top two athletes is unable to attend) to represent Saskatchewan in the sport of ISSF 10m Air Rifle Shooting the 2011 Canada Games team in accordance to the following criteria:

Athletes will be ranked according to the “Top 4” qualification round (60 shots for men, 40 shots for women) plus the “Top 3 Junior Finals”, with the highest possible score of 1927 for women and 2727 for men, at the following competitions/training camps:

September 11-12, 2010 - Junior Development Squad Training Camp, Saskatoon
Phase 1 of 4 of CWG Final Selection 1 qualification course + 1 junior final

October 16 – 17, 2010 - Canada Games Training Clinic, Saskatoon
Phase 2 of 4 of CWG Final Selection 1 qualification course + 1 junior final

December 17 - 19, 2010 – 2010 Air Rifle Championships, Saskatoon
Phase 3 of 4 of CWG Final Selection 2 qualification courses + 1 junior final

January 8 - 9, 2011 - Training Camp, Saskatoon
Phase 4 of 4 of CWG final selection 3 qualification courses + 1 junior final

Team selection will be publicly announced on January 11th, 2011.

Changes to this selection criteria will be avoided if possible, but may occur if a situation arises that is out of the control of the SPSBA.
